Capital Tax Issues (Stamp Duty)

5. The Group was briefed on the yields and current issues in relation to stamp duties including residential and non-residential property, shares, ATM and credit cards, and insurance levies. It was noted that the Programme for Government 2007-2012 provided for the Government to legislate immediately to abolish stamp duty for first time buyers and Finance (No. 2) Act 2007 dealt with this commitment.
